This week we observed Rosh Chodesh Adar "Alef". The Jewish calendar inserts a thirteenth month seven times every nineteen years. This method of leap years keeps our lunar calendar in relative sync with the solar calendar. The extra month is inserted as an Adar "Alef", thereby causing Purim to be observed in the second Adar (Adar "Sheni"). The intent is to keep Purim and Pesach close to each other. Both holidays commemorate a redemption; and in the language of Talmud, we juxtapose the redemptions together, "*samchinan geulah l'geulah*". In every year, Adar heralds a season of joy and anticipated happiness.
