

Prom Policy

Senior/Junior Prom

❖ **Time/venue:**

- 7 PM to 11 PM on April 28, 2017
- Philmont Country Club
- Students must remain in the prom area from 7 PM to 11 PM

❖ **Dress Code:**

- Please select dance attire that reflects the standards of Saint Basil Academy
- Formal attire required: long gowns for ladies, tuxedos or formal suits for gentlemen
- No low-cut fronts or backs
- No cutouts
- No bare or sheer midriffs
- Dresses with halter tops may be worn if all of the above directives are met
- Failure to respect the dress code may result in disciplinary action. The decision will be made by administration and the moderators.

❖ **Admission**

- Only students that have paid in advance will be admitted
- The cost is \$115 for SBA students and \$60 for an escort
- Payment must be made by Feb. 24, 2017
- Girls from other schools than SBA will not be admitted
- Students may invite a male student as an escort
- Information forms including the names, addresses and telephone numbers of the girls and their dates will be returned to the prom adviser prior to the prom

❖ **Music**

- The DJ and music will be approved in advance
- Inappropriate dancing is prohibited. At the discretion of the faculty, parents will be contacted immediately and required to come to the prom for the student and/or escort.

❖ **General Policies:**

- The use of alcohol and drugs is strictly prohibited before, during, or after the prom
- If an SBA student or escort shows signs of intoxication or drug use before or during the prom, parents will be contacted immediately and required to come to the prom for the student and/or escort.
- Law enforcement officers may also be contacted.
- The use of alcohol or drugs may result in the expulsion of the students. Seniors may be denied the privilege of graduating with their class. All parents will be required to sign a pledge that will not serve alcoholic beverages in their home the night of the prom.
- Smoking is prohibited. Infractions by anyone will result in the completion of an incident report, which will be shared with the school of the offending student.
- The SBA students are expected to show respect to the faculty and chaperones. They are responsible for the behavior of their guests.
- Saint Basil Academy does not sanction post-prom parties or trips. Should they occur, they will be the complete responsibility of the parents.
