About the Pre-Employment Screening Program

- The Pre-Employment Screening Program (PSP) is a U.S. Department of Transportation Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA) program. PSP helps motor carriers make more informed hiring decisions by providing secure, electronic access to a commercial driver's five-year crash and three-year inspection history. Background screening companies may access the data on behalf of the employer during the hiring process.
- In the past year PSP has undergone changes. This presentation will inform the audience of program enhancements including a new service called PSP Monitoring; as well as the inclusion of not preventable crash data in PSP records.
