**Social Media Etiquette** - Design and offer a virtual workshop to teach the ladies:

1. What they should and should not do on their social media platforms.
2. How to separate personal and business platforms.

**Virtual Interviews** - Teach residents how to prepare and perform successful interviews over Zoom or web-conferencing services.

### Program

**Intake** - Intake volunteers help answer the crisis line, return phone calls, educate applicants on the Road to Freedom Program and pray with applicants. Training will be provided. Intake can be done remotely and scheduling is flexible.

**Driver** - Take women and children to appointments. Driving needs and times vary and a flexible schedule is preferred. Distance driving can be anywhere between San Francisco and Sacramento. Current long distance driving needs are Highland Hospital in Oakland, Santa Clara courts and San Francisco. Drivers wait in their vehicle or waiting rooms while residents are at their appointment, then bring them back to Shepherd's Gate after the appointment is finished.

*Process required to become a driver:*

1. Interview with Nina Gribben
2. Complete a DMV Authorization Report
3. Insurance Verification
