Dear Families of St. Jerome Parish School:

We are excited to announce we are partnering with St. Jerome Parish School to bring meals to your students. Locally we serve the Oconomowoc Area School District and are glad St. Jerome can join our meal service program.

Beginning Monday December 7, 2020, your student(s) will have access to lunch at school daily. There will be both a hot & a cold option available, along with fruits, vegetables and milk. The United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) has extended waivers which allow meals to be served free to all students thru June 30, 2021 or until funding is discontinued. This means that **any** student can eat lunch for free each day.

For the first week, we are asking that you indicate if your student(s) will be taking lunch so that we can establish the amount of meals to have available. After the first week, your student(s) can simply come down to the cafeteria and choose to get lunch without ordering ahead. The menu is enclosed with this communication, as well as the link to the first week's form.

We also want to make you aware that a meal distribution program exists for the Oconomowoc community for students who are electing to stay virtual or are required to be home for any reason. Families are eligible to pick-up meals for students 18 years of age & younger when they are NOT in school. There is a form available to order ahead. Pick-up occurs Mondays from 4-6 pm at Door 33 of Oconomowoc High School (next to the Tailgate Area). All information, including a map, is available on the order form. The form link will be included with this communication.
