Mission Statement

Seeking to put God's love into action, Habitat for Humanity brings people together to build homes, communities, and hope.

Who is Habitat for Humanity?

Habitat for Humanity is a global non-profit housing organization working in local communities across all 50 states in the U.S. and in approximately 70 countries. Habitat's vision is of a world where everyone has a decent place to live.

What is the Faith Build Program?

Founded in 2015, the Faith Build brings people of faith together to sponsor a home. Each congregation gives a portion of prayer, volunteer power, and funding to build a home for a family. To date, the Faith Build program has brought 49 congregations together to build 15 homes sold to 15 families containing 17 people with 36 children. Your work not only serves a family, but also revitalizes a neighborhood.

Location & Time Frame

In 2025, our Faith Build home will be located on the East side in the Mt. Pleasant neighborhood. The Faith Build home will be 1 of 10 homes being built on the street. From June to December, groups will select 3 or more build dates to volunteer onsite. You do not have to volunteer to support the Faith Build.



Volunteering

- Volunteers must be 16 years of age or older. All skill levels are welcome. Volunteers work alongside Habitat construction staff.
- There are opportunities to work on a construction site or on a Spruce-Up day with many other Faith Groups.
- If construction isn't your cup of tea- we can share off-site volunteering and non-construction options.

Sponsorship

Building a home is expensive! Sponsorships vary with the average starting commitment at \$5,000. We can work with faith groups to help connect them with other partners and provide fundraising tools and other ingenious ideas.
