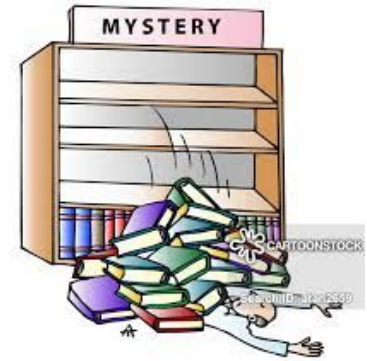


# March Mystery Musters
