### **PROM INFORMATION:**

The **Senior Prom** will be held on **Monday**, **June 6**, **2022**, from **6:30 to 10:30 p.m.**, at Waterfront Park. It will be catered by Harvest on Hudson. This will be an elegant, tented event, with an amazing DJ, fabulous food, a photo booth, and lots of energy!

- Attendees may use the Harvest on Hudson restrooms.
- Attendees should not drive to the event, as there will not be parking. There will be a drop-off spot.
- Officers will be directing traffic flow in the parking lot and patrolling the perimeter of the Park.
- Waterfront Park will be open for attendees, their guests, and chaperones only.

### **GRADUATION INFORMATION:**

The Graduation Ceremony will be held on <u>Thursday</u>, <u>June 23</u>, <u>beginning at</u> 6:00 p.m., on the Burke Estate (weather permitting). The Ceremony will also be live streamed through Local Live.

- If we are inside, the ceremony will be held in the Cochran Gym, with simulcasting through Local Live.
- We do not issue tickets for the Graduation Ceremony.
   You may bring as many guests as you like. Please be considerate if the ceremony is indoors due to inclement weather.
- National Honor Society and National Art Honor Society members will be given their sashes/ropes on Graduation Day. Sashes/ropes must be returned following the ceremony to one of the chaperones. The cap, gown, and tassel are yours to keep.

Graduation rehearsal will take place at 11:30 a.m. on <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>June 22</u>, in the High School auditorium.

- Prior to graduation rehearsal, we will meet at 9:45 a.m. at the Hillside School circle. Seniors will wear the t-shirt that was given to them with their caps & gowns. The seniors will walk through the halls of Hillside, where the elementary students will "clap them through."
- Students are not to bring caps & gowns to rehearsal. It is recommended that you steam the gown or press it using a cool setting on your iron.

On **Graduation Day, June 23**, all seniors are to report to the **High School Auditorium by 5:00 p.m., with caps & gowns**. (In the unfortunate event of inclement weather, line-up will be in the Green Gym, and Graduation will be held in the Cochran Gym.)

<u>Photos during Ceremony:</u> There will be a professional photographer from Legacy Studios at the graduation ceremony. Two photographs will be taken of each graduate:

- 1.) Receiving his/her diploma
- 2.) After exiting the stage
