Each BLT is composed of a school principal, two teachers, two parents, two students, and one non-instructional staff member. Currently, there is 1 parent vacancy at Hillside and 1 parent vacancy at Hastings High School.

Regular attendance of committee members is important. **The BLTs meet from 3:15-4:15 pm on three Mondays during the school year. This year, the meetings are November 9, January 25, and March 8 - but please note that these dates are subject to change.**
