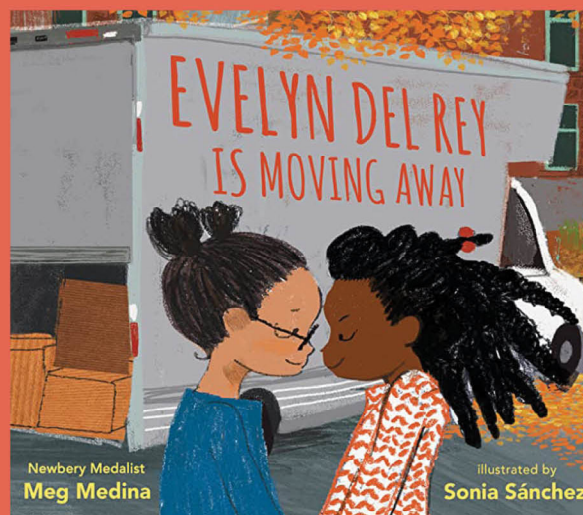
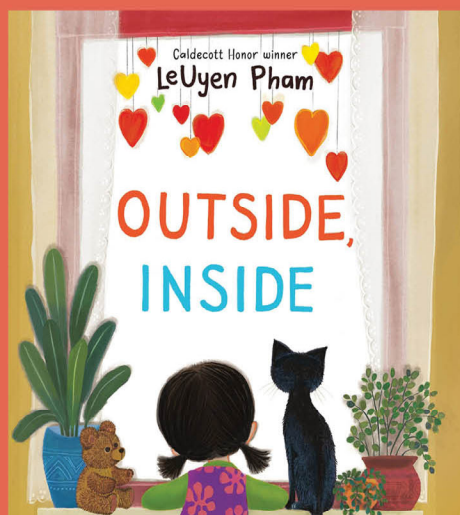


STORIES THAT SPEAK: PERSPECTIVE THROUGH PICTURE BOOKS
