When Aristotle enrolled in the WIOA program last spring, he hoped to identify an opportunity through the coordinated services offered at the PA CareerLink® Bucks County. He previously worked as an administrative assistant and wanted to focus on job placement in office administration.

Aristotle worked closely with a workforce counselor. Together they reviewed employment and training options available through the On-the-Job Training (OJT) program, which would provide a swift return to work with additional training needed to secure sustainable employment.

While conducting research, Aristotle identified an opportunity with Medihill Medical Alert Systems in Bensalem, PA. He believed that a posted general clerk position would be a good fit with the requisite skill set he developed over time. Upon completing the enrollment, assessment, and interview process, he formally enrolled in the OJT. Later in the fall, Aristotle completed the training process and was hired as a full-time employee.

Aristotle found a career in which he enjoys the day-to-day tasks and environment. His experience in the OJT program helped him secure a significantly higher wage. Additionally, Aristotle's employer reports that he has maintained excellent attendance and demonstrates a strong work ethic.
