The Wardrobe, formerly Career Wardrobe, is a nonprofit social enterprise that uses clothing to inspire change. Founded in 1995, The Wardrobe has outfitted over 90,000 people with the attire needed to succeed in life.

The Wardrobe's mission is to end clothing insecurity - that can mean not having anything to wear or not having the right thing to wear. Appointments are open to people of all genders and sizes. Clients can receive up to 4 free personal styling appointments a year, each with the clothing that meets their needs - from casual to workwear.
