

The school uniform is required for all students in Beginners-8th grade and consists of any color polo or jumper/dress with The Summit logo and khaki or navy bottoms. Fridays, and other select days throughout the year, are considered "Spirit Wear Days." **\*\*NOTE: Every student will need at least one RED POLO shirt to wear with khaki pants/skirts at the fall & spring music concerts and on field trips.**

High school students adhere to a dress code consisting of logoed shirts/tops/dresses or spirit wear shirts with jeans, khaki, or navy pants/shorts/skirts Monday-Friday.

- Our school's preferred number is 9001-0357-3. Any colors or any pieces found under this link are considered part of the approved uniform.
- If you cannot find a specific type/color you are looking for under the approved items, please email Amy Maas, and she will check on the item.
- Please note that you can purchase khaki or navy bottoms (pants, shorts, skirts) from any store (ie: Target, JCPenney's, online, etc.). They do NOT have to be purchased from Lands End.
- Lands End is our exclusive logoed apparel provider for this school year (2017-2018). We hope to outsource to local embroidery companies in the years to come, and I will keep you updated as we move forward with that.

- **Used Uniform Pieces:** We have a used uniform rack of gently used polos, dresses, sweaters, sweatshirts, spirit wear, pants, shorts, skirts, etc. available to the community.
  - Purchase used uniform pieces for \$5/piece.
  - You can swap uniform pieces (both tops and bottoms) evenly (ie. put in 1 of your used uniforms and take 1 used uniform piece) as often as you like and for no charge. This is an "on your honor" system.
  - Pieces are available at a first come, first served basis. We will not hold sizes at the front desk
- **Sweaters & Jackets:** It is highly recommend at least one logoed sweater or sweatshirt for each student, as the building does get cold during the winter months. Students do not need a logoed coat to wear for outdoor recess, but when in the building students' outer most layer must have either The Summit logo or is an approved spirit wear item.
- **Spirit Wear:** Spirit wear consists of shirts, sweatshirts, etc. that are either official items sold through the school, school event shirts (ie. Summit Run, Camp Raven, Dance Shirts), or class shirts that have been approved by the school. Every Friday, students, faculty, and staff may wear spirit wear with jean pants or shorts/skirts **\*\*Note: Shorts/skirts must still meet the guidelines for length listed below) or the uniform khaki/navy pants/shorts/skirts.**
  - It is NOT required that student, faculty, or staff wear spirit wear on Friday, it is just an option. If they choose not to wear Summit Spirit wear, they must wear the school uniform.
  - Note: There are a few weeks this year when school is not in session on Fridays. In these rare instances, spirit wear may be worn the Thursday before (the last day of school for the week).
- **\$2 Uniform Dress Out Days:** At least once a month, students, faculty, and staff will have the opportunity to "buy out" of their uniform for \$2 per individual. Participation is NOT required on these days, and individuals may instead opt to wear their uniform that day. Cash will be collected in the lobby

on these days; individuals should bring their \$2 with them those mornings. The funds of each “buy out” day will be designated for a specific fund or charity, more information will be released prior to those days. The dates will be listed on the official school calendar.

- **Lands’ End Scrip Cards:** *When purchasing new uniforms from Lands’ End, I HIGHLY recommend using a Scrip card, as their rebates are 16%!!* It doesn’t cost you anything extra, and you’re getting money back on something you’d already be purchasing... it’s almost like FREE money!! Physical gift cards on hand at the front desk for you to purchase, or you can use the mobile website ([My Scrip Wallet](#)), and purchase them online.

### Uniforms

The outermost piece of clothing must have the school logo on it (polo shirt or jacket, etc). Students must wear khaki or navy bottoms, purchased from any vendor (ie: Target, online, or boutiques).

Skirts and shorts may be worn, but shorts must have at least a 5" inseam and skirts must be knee length. Each Summit student will need a red Summit polo to wear for field trips and concerts.

Footwear must have a closed heel and toe. The best option is an athletic shoe.

- Used Uniforms: We have some used uniforms available at the school for \$5 per item or an even trade. Please check in with the front desk before making a purchase or trade. Donations are always welcome.
- Lands End: Uniforms are available for purchase through [Lands End](#). The Summit’s preferred number when placing orders is **9001-0357-3**.
- Buy Out/Dress Out of Uniform Days: The Summit has designated a couple days throughout the school year as buyout days, where students may choose to pay \$2 to dress out of uniform (see school calendar for exact days). Students are not required to participate in buy out days and may choose to wear their school uniform instead on those days.
- Jeans Days: Every Friday students will be allowed to wear jeans with their Summit tops (either uniform or Summit Spirit Wear).  
Jean shorts and skirts should follow the same length guidelines as uniform shorts/skirts.

Summit Spirit Wear: Classified as tops related to a Summit event, ie: Summit Run, dance t-shirts, class t-shirts, or those purchased through a Summit Spirit Wear order. These tops may be worn on Fridays with jeans.

### Modifications of Uniform Dress Code for High School Students

The following modifications of the Uniform Dress Code apply to students in grades 9-12: in addition to the apparel indicated above, high school students may wear Summit spirit and event wear, including upper-wear related to Summit athletic events; conservative cut blue jeans (excludes leggings as outer-wear, jeans/pants with tears, jeans/pants that are excessively baggy/tight). *(These modifications apply daily, Monday through Friday)*
