



Generations of Indian Valley Announces a New Rental Policy

The Generations Board of Directors, Staff, and Volunteers have approved a new rental policy which outlines the procedure for rentals as well as the costs. We would welcome community partners - local businesses, civic organizations, and nonprofit agencies to consider either the Generations Community Room or Generations Café as the venue for off-site events.

Generations has served older adults in our community for over 50 years, and all through its organizational life, Generations has placed a priority on supporting the broader community as well. Recently, we completed a major renovation to our largest space, the Charles H. Allebach, Jr. Community Room, with the intent of beautifying this space both for our daily participants and for additional outside events.

Since its renovation, the space has hosted events sponsored by the Pennsylvania Department of Aging and Governor Shapiro, Montgomery County Office of Aging Services, Senator Collett, Representative Malagari, the Indian Valley Public Library, the Doylestown Art League, the R5 Horn Club, The Souderton-Telford Historical Society, and additional private functions. The space can accommodate as many as 180 people.

The Generations Café offers a smaller, informal space for special events up to 50 people.

Generations' facilities are not available for rent to the general public for private events or for organizations whose purpose does not align with our mission.
