With population growth comes consistent change in who lives here, cultural needs, and community interests (and leadership).

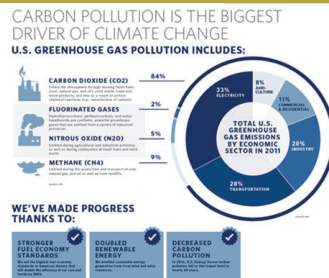


Protecting Natural and Historic Resources

Hurricane Ida repairs and cleanup have cost the county \$23 million+ -- how will we continue to build back and how can we plan for future storm/weather events?



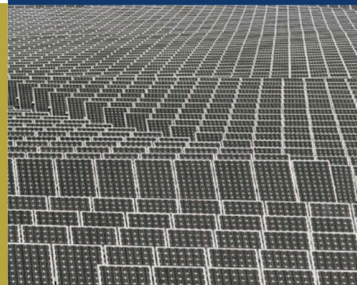
Health Concerns
