

NAVIGATING AMIDST TURBULENCE & UNCERTAINTY: MOVING ALONG THE FOUR PATHWAYS OF SOCIAL JUSTICE

Many people struggle with how to do social justice work well. This two-part workshop focuses on both “how to be” socially just during times of injustice, and “how to do” the work along a continuum. You will be introduced to the four Pathways of Social Justice, a framework developed by the Social Justice Initiative (SJI) housed at Bryn Mawr College. While best utilized together, each workshop part is designed to stand alone.

- Part I: Cultural Humility & Courage and Compassion
- Part II: Forgiveness & Radical Love

We will discuss how each individual Pathway can help illuminate how to address problems and dilemmas that can arise within many organizational functions, such as leadership style, staffing decisions, financial and human resource systems, and both internal and community-level aspects of organizational settings.
