## CENTRAL BUCKS HOST SITE LOCATIONS

**December: Neshaminy Warwick Presbyterian, Warminster January: Our Lady of Guadalupe, Buckingham**  
**February: Doylestown Presbyterian Church, Doylestown March: St. Paul's Lutheran Church, Doylestown**

Shelter opens December – March when overnight temperature is **28°** or colder (including wind chill), and every **WEDNESDAY** regardless of overnight low temperature **ONLY** if all volunteer shifts are fully staffed.

Open/close status updated daily by 9 am : call 866-390-0291 x 701 or check [centralbuckscodeblue.org](http://centralbuckscodeblue.org) online.

Shelter hours: 7:30 p.m. – 6:45 a.m.

**Must be 18 years or older to stay at the Code Blue shelter.**



## Free Transportation is Available – CSSH Van

**The pick up time for all van stops for the entire Code Blue Season is now 7pm.**

Passengers must be at all CSSH Van stops by 6:50 to be sure they do not miss their ride to the shelter.

The 7pm pick up time will be in effect through end of season, at the end of March.

The van route is variable, but it will arrive between 7pm – 8pm each night. Multiple runs may be required and the route pick up order may change from time to time based on numbers, so please be patient and wait, the van will arrive.

- Bus Shelter, Clinton St. near Septa Train Station, Doylestown
- Bus Shelter at County Courthouse Crosswalk on North Main st. Doylestown
- Walmart Supercenter, at picnic table, not store entrance, 100 E. Street Rd., Warminster.
