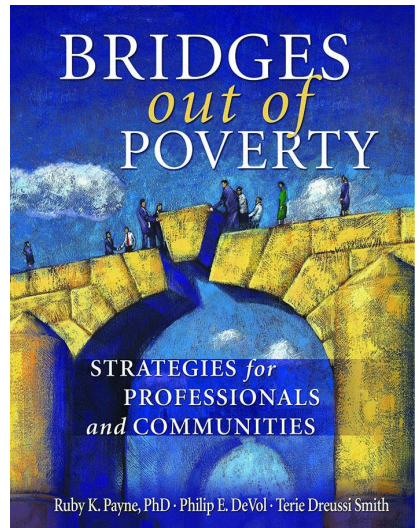
This training is free to all attendees. Registration is required, with a max of 3 people per organization. Thank you!
