Montgomery County's Homes For All Initiative is working to ensure that everyone who lives, works, learns and invests in Montgomery County has equal opportunity to live in an affordable home and a thriving community. However, as the cost of housing increases at a rapid rate, residents of Montgomery County are finding it nearly impossible to purchase, maintain, or stay in homes that support their families and futures.

Community Land Trusts, or CLTs, are one way a nonprofit or community organization can get involved to preserve land as a lasting asset for housing affordability in their neighborhood. Black farmers and civil rights leaders developed the model over 50 years ago, and today, organizations leverage it to meet urgent community needs, providing affordable rental and cooperative housing, permanently affordable homeownership, and quality spaces. There are more than 316 Community Land Trusts in the United States.
