Black Rooster also has a rooftop bar where patrons can sit outside and get a perfect view of the skyline and the Congaree River. Niemi announced in December 2023 that in the new year, Black Rooster would switch to an Italian menu. We sat down with him to ask a few questions.

What was the reasoning for going Italian?

"With the closing of Al's upstairs. I felt it was a perfect opportunity to change the menu and give West Columbia a casual upscale place for Italian. I think everybody has an interest in Italian, much more so than French, which seems to be a bit daunting to many diners. Even though French is ubiquitous in our everyday meals in America, I think a lot of people think it is fancy and only for special occasions. Italian, on the other hand, is much more approachable." Talk about your location overlooking the Congaree River.

"Our location, with its beautiful views of the rivers, and the cityscape, is definitely a drawing point for our place. It is really hard to beat the view as the sun sets on the cityscape."

How do you like doing business in West Columbia?

"Doing business in West Columbia has been a dream. From the moment we started construction through the pandemic and on, it has been a fantastic experience. Everybody in city government and administration has been so helpful and supportive of our business since the day we opened. The residents of the area have also been super supportive. It's just a great place to do business and be a part of the community."

SCRATCH N' SPIN RECORD SHOP IS A UNIQUE BUSINESS IN WEST COLUMBIA'S TRIANGLE CITY

Scratch N' Spin record shop is in West Columbia's Triangle City at 513 12th Street. It's been there for 20 years and it's here to stay. "We're at the ideal location in Triangle City," said Eric Woodard, owner of Scratch N' Spin. "There is a downtown feel in Triangle City and there are a lot of vital businesses in the 12th Street area. Everyone knows where Zesto is and we get a lot of traffic here." What will you find there? Scratch N' Spin's storefront is adorned with images of: Super Mario; Taylor Swift; Spider-Man; The Hulk; Jimi Hendrix; and X-Men.

Scratch N' Spin sells vinyl record albums and the turntables to play

the records. Woodard said the market for turntables spans a wide range of buyers.

"Anywhere from college-age to middle-age are in the market for turntables and vinyl records these days," Woodard said. The store also sells vintage record albums. Anything from KISS and Bob Dylan to Michael Jackson and The Rolling

Records and players are not the only thing you'll find at Scratch N' Spin. The business is full of inventory and also sells movies, TV series on DVD, action figures, and more. The store can get any ordered item, overnight, if it's not in stock. Woodard said the fact that his shop does not specialize in any one type of item is an advantage.

"We're not a specialty shop where you just buy one thing," he said. "We have a diversity of items and because of that we have a solid and steady clientele."
