Senator Terry Moulton is a small business owner in Chippewa Falls and owns Mouldy's Archery and Tackle. He was elected in 2011 to represent the 23rd district which includes parts of Marshfield, Wood, Marathon, and most of Clark County. He previously represented the 68th district in the Wisconsin Assembly from 2005 to 2009. Senator Moulton was the vice-chair of the Natural Resources Committee, chairman of the Agriculture, Small Business and Tourism Committee, vice-chairman of the Health and Human Services Committee, and a member of the Sporting Heritage, Mining and Forestry Committee. He also served on the Joint Legislative Council, the Governor's Council on Tourism, and was vice-chairman of the State Building Commission.

Representative Lee Nerison was born in La Crosse and lives in Westby. He is a former dairy farmer and was elected to the Wisconsin Assembly in 2005 representing the 96th Assembly District which includes Vernon and Crawford counties and part of Monroe County. He is the chair of the Wisconsin Assembly Committee on Agriculture and a member of the Committee on Natural Resources and Sporting Heritage, the Committee on Veterans and Military Affairs, and the Committee on Consumer Protection.
