## What is Harvest of Care?

Harvest of Care is a regional initiative of AZIPL as part of our dedication to food justice.

Too many of people in our region go hungry and too many of our neighbors do not have access to nutritious fruits and vegetables. We are working with faith-based communities to establish vegetable gardens on the properties they steward, working toward the shared goals of:

1. Caring for Creation
2. Growing Healthy Communities, and
3. Nourishing the Hungry

## How Does A Harvest of Care Garden Work?

AZIPL has funding to provide assistance in developing three Harvest of Care Gardens in Prescott in 2018 - 2019. ***We will provide tools and assistance to each garden participant, including:***

1. Assistance in planning, developing and maintaining each Harvest of Care Garden
2. Access to experts through the Yavapai County Extension Office
3. Volunteer Coordination
4. Partnerships for Food Distribution

In addition, AZIPL will coordinate workshops, classes and discussions with participating congregations. These will engage youth and adults alike, providing a curriculum to engage all members of your congregation. Let's explore together the connections of spirituality to care of the Earth.

## ***Harvest of Care Gardens participants will:***

1. Dedicate a portion of the property they steward to growing vegetables
2. Have a designated garden caretaker who coordinates with AZIPL and
3. Donate a minimum of 50% of the food produced to the hungry
