

# St Luke's Re-Gathering Survey Results

Dear St Luke's Family:

The parish leadership would like to hear from you as we preparing a plan to safely regather in our church building when we will have the green light from the diocese. Please take this survey by Sunday, July 12 at 5 pm so the Regathering Committee can process the results and advise the Vestry.

As you already know, at this time, we do not have a specific date for re-opening. Any potential regathering date will depend on a 14-day decline of Covid-19 cases in Yavapai Count and diocesan approval.

When public worship resumes, it will not be the same as before during the "Phase 2": Masks will be required in the building by everyone at all times. Gathering sizes will be limited. Social distancing of at least six feet will be required unless you are with a member of your household. Congregational singing will not be possible.

When we eventually re-open the building, you don't have to return to church if you are not comfortable. Some will return as soon as possible; some will wait until the Fall; some will wait until there is a vaccine. Only you will know what is best for you and your health. In the meantime, we will continue to offer our Worship Services Online as we continue to navigate this pandemic.

May God continue to bless each of you during this time.




How interested would you be in attending an in-person service with the above-mentioned restrictions in place?


If you're interested in attending an in-person worship service would you also be willing to utilize an online sign-up system to attend church (because we have space limitations)


How many total people in your household will be attending church (i.e. 0, 1, 2, 3 or 4, etc.)? \*


Do you need any tech support to watch our church services?


Chapel, Saturday 5:00 pm


Church, Sunday 8:00 am


Church, Sunday 10:00 am


Would you be interested in a Sunday service at Noon in the Church?


If we can't have two services in a row in the same place, would you be willing to attend a service in the Parish Hall at 8:00 AM?


If we can't have two services in a row in the same place, would you be willing to attend a service in the Parish Hall at Noon?


Traditionally we had a Healing Service on Wednesday at 10:00 am. Would you be interested to attend this service?


