Hoping that 2021 is coming in gently. Despite very challenging pandemic conditions, BC early childhood communities working with ECPN pedagogists have been responding in novel ways to engage with the vision of the [Early Childhood Pedagogy Network](#).

Given the limitations that living with COVID-19 presents for programs, pedagogists are reimagining how to use technology creatively in their work with educators. Pedagogists are virtually 'walking alongside' educators and centres to create the conditions for conviviality and collective curriculum engagement (e.g., by visiting programs via ZOOM, interacting regularly through email and other digital modalities, creating synchronous learning circles and asynchronous pedagogist-led discussions on the [BC Early Years Professional Development Hub](#)).
