Committee Reports

Notices Committee-Cheryl/Maricopa: Asked for input on a meeting time between Saturday at 9am or every other Wednesday at 6pm.

Diane/Maricopa asked if the Constitution committee was taking the place of the Notices Committee. Dennis/Coconino responded that as there were not a lot of notices now, time left after business in that committee would be used for the Constitution committee.

Cheryl/Maricopa: We will meet Saturdays at 9am, and the first meeting is April 18, 2026 at 9am on <http://meetn.com/thearizonaassembly>. Notice to Secretary of State Marco Rubio demanding the Arizona Department of Revenue be shut down has been sent. A congratulations letter was sent to the newly-commissioned Continental Marshall. The Protocols Version 9 are done. Continuing research being done on how to stop data centers from collecting our information.

Dennis/Coconino: Called for volunteers for the Constitution Committee

Constitution Committee-Cheryl/Maricopa: Meeting on Saturdays at 9am to begin reviewing and discussing amending or re-writing our Constitution for Arizona. Versions found were 1864, 1891 and the ratified Municipal version from 1912. Held on Meetn.com/thearizonaassembly.
