### **New Business**

### **Committee Reports**

**Notices Committee-Cheryl/Maricopa:** They continue to meet every Saturday morning at 9am. Everyone is welcome to join us. We send out notices to the bond companies that insure our elected officials in the State of Arizona for any bad conduct or violations of their oaths. We received a letter back from one of the companies and Dennis/Coconino managed to reach them on the phone. Not only are they providing bonding state officials, but there are also five or so insurance companies involved in insuring them. We are going to follow up on that. We do have liens against all the state officials. They are also drafting a letter to send to Marco Rubio, as they have discovered that the Arizona Department of Revenue is a franchise of the Secretary of States office DC. We are going to demand that he shut it down because we do not owe taxes. We are also researching data centers so we can get them shut down because they are environmentally unsound and engaged in collecting peoples meta data and surveilling Americans every move which is unconstitutional. They also have negative health impacts on the people living in the surrounding communitites. If you are interested in helping us research where they are building new data centers. As well as other important information about them, please let Cheryl, Dennis or Diane know because we are trying to get some of those shut down.

**Constitution Committee-Dennis/Coconino:** Starting soon, right after they finish updating the protocols, the people on the protocol committee will start working on the Constitution. Cheryl/Maricopa tells us that as soon as the new protocols have been voted on at the end of March, they will use the same slot on the second and fourth Wednesday of every month at 6:30pm to segway into the Constitution Committee. So that will be starting up the second Wednesday of March. If anyone is interested in working on the Constitution Committee, we could use your help. The DeFacto has made so many addendums to the Constitution that it no longer applies to the common law that was originally set up for the state of Arizona. Please let Cheryl or Dennis know if you're interested in working on that.

**Meet n Greet Committee-Polly/Yavapai:** There was a discussion on whether or not they should have the spring Meet n Greet since there is a big 250 year anniversary event in Philadelphia that a lot of ASNs are going to be attending. Diane/Maricopa points out

that the Meet n Greet is in May and the Philadelphia event is in July and wonders if Dennis/Cocnino is thinking that a lot of people can't afford to attend both, so he's just putting it out there to see what everybody else thinks. Dennis says he's planning on going to Philadelphia if we get our funding. Diane/Maricopa says that the point of the Meet n Greet is for us to get together and get to know each other, the Philadelphia event is going to have ASNs from all over the Country and is a totally different kind of event. She advocates for having the Meet N Greet regardless because we need to see each other face to face' meet new members and promote the cohesiveness of this Assembly Cheryl/Maricopa agrees that we should still have our Meet N Greet as per usual. Polly/Yavapai interjects that George has already made the reservations for the park in Prescott and we need to put the deposit down. Polly says she is also in favor of having the meet n greet. Lou Anne/Maricopa says she would love to go to Philadelphia if we get our funding, and that she has people in the area that may be able to provide lodging for our contingency, and that she is in favor of still having the meet n greet. Polly/Yavapai informs us that the only date that they could get for the meet n greet was May 23, 2026 FYI. We have the pavillion booked from 11am till 3pm. The deposit is \$282.50. The meet n greet is a potluck. The Assembly has paper plates napkins and cups. If you bring cases of water or other beverages you'll take what ever is left over home and they may have some containers for left overs. The meet n greet will be at A.C. Williams Granite Creek Park in Prescott. An Email invite will be sent out to everyone as we get closer to the date.

**Outreach Committee-Diane/Maricopa:** Diane says the committee is “kicking butt”, We are working on an introductory letter to send to podcasts and video content creators to see if we can get them interested in interviewing us to helping us spread our message to a wider audience. We are working on some informational handouts to get people interested in learning more. LouAnne contacted the staff from Bike week. You have to book a booth for all four days for \$1500. They said they could give us 30% off, but that is still too expensive so we're going to look for other less expensive events. If anyone knows of upcoming events anywhere in Arizona that would be a good event for us to attend to do outreach, please talk to the event planner and find out how much a booth would cost or see if they would be willing to give us a space for a table. **Litigation Committee-Dennis/Coconino:** There is no litigation committee at this time until we find some people who want to start it up again.

**Banking Committe-Cheryl/Maricopa:** The committee will resume their meetings soon because we are getting closer to getting our funding. **Treasury Committee-Marc Silliman:** Marc/Navajo is setting up a new committee, he is interested in having some people work with him to help him prepare for the “big day” when we receive our funding. We want to have a good process and protocols in place to receive the funds and also to catalogue all the assets of Arizona. That will be part of the Treasury's responsibilities. **Website Committee-Diane/Maricopa:** The website committee hasn't met recently because they are without someone who is familiar with word press to be their web master. They have some glitches they need to get worked out so they can move forward.

**Ombudsman Committee-George Musienga:** No report

**Protocol Committee-Cheryl/Maricopa:** We are finishing up Protocols Version 9. Protocol Version 8 is linked at the bottom of the Agenda. Please make sure you read it so you know how to conduct yourselves during meetings so we can conduct our meetings smoothly and efficiently. This is about getting things done. Most of our work is done in committees and during the State meetings we just give reports. She believes they will have the protocols ready for us to look at by the next meeting on March 10, 2026. We'll have 2 weeks to look at them and make changes, then we'll vote on them at the end of March. If you want to be on the protocol committee, you must've been active on the State calls and on other committees for at least a year. **Vender Research Committee-Dennis/Coconino:** This committee is for researching the vendors we are eventually going to have to contract for services when we take get our funding and take over our State Trust. Meeting on Wednesday March 4, 2026. This will be a subcommittee of the Banking and Treasury Committees.

**Data Center Research-Diane/Maricopa:** We are pulling together as much information as we can about data centers on Arizona. It has been difficult so far for Diane to get much information on who is building the data centers or locations that have been slated for one. It would seem that the Planning and Zoning Commissions of the various counties are trying to keep any information on plans for data centers on the down low. People have been sending her information as they run across it, and that's what she needs. Anyone who has any connections to someone who may be privy to info on planned data centers or if you run across an article or a video about data centers, not just location and builder info, but info on environmental or human health impacts, etc. please send to Diane at Maricopacoordinator@icloud.com. She is compiling this info so we can write notices and public laws regarding these data centers and start noticing the people responsible for them and get them shut down.

**Marshall at Arms-Duncan/Pinal:** I have finally settled on what I'm going to say at his planned meeting at the DMV. Hopefully he will have a report for the notices committee on Saturday's meeting.

**International Business Assembly-Cheryl/Maricopa:** They continue to meet on the first and third Wednesday of every month at 6pm. For the new people, the International Business Assembly deals with all of the vendors for Arizona. They pay the bills for the State and they also make agreements with other States for their goods and services. Their committee is international in scope. They meet with Terra Australia, Canada, Nova Zealandia, South Africa to name a few of the countries that get on their calls. They are forging relationships, and comparing notes with each other. You must have your 928 papers done to be on this committee.

**New Committees forming-Dennis/Coconino:** Banking and Treasury Committees being formed, please contact Cheryl/Maricopa or Marc/Navajo respectively or Dennis/Coconino if you are interested in joining either of those committees.

**X (Twitter) Account-Dennis/Coconino:** Do we want to set up an X account for the Assembly? This idea had come out of the Outreach committee. Lou Anne had offered to set up an X account for the Arizona Assembly. After discussion the committee decided rather than setting up an official Arizona Assembly account that someone would have to monitor, we decided that she could set up a channel of her own that she could post things on. She is aware that there are certain documents or information about the Arizona Assembly that would require her to get permission to post, but that she could post general info about State Nationals, status correction etc on her own.

**Q & A-Dennis/Coconino:** The Q & A session starts at 6pm before every General Assembly meeting. This is where you can get all your questions answered about moving forward and get education for new people coming in.

**Current Protocols-Dennis/Coconino:** Link 5 on the Agenda will bring up Protocols Version 8. Please make sure you read those. Everyone coming in to the Assembly should read and understand the protocols. Diane/Maricopa makes an announcement because there are quite a few women on the call who just did their paper work and are new to the Assembly. She says she usually gives them a copy of the protocols when she does peoples paper work and also talks to them about decorum, but this time, because the protocols are about to be updated, she did not give them a copy of Version 8 since it will shortly be outdated. She appologizes if that has caused confision for anyone, but as soon as the Protocols are updated, she will send the new version out to everybody.

**Need new Court Clerk and Justices for the State, We will also need all those positions for the Counties as well.**

**Call to Public Office:** If you click on that link you will find explanations of the duties of all the various positions that are available.

**Open Forum:** How to get new topics on the State Agenda, Questions, comments or suggestions that you want to get on the agenda can be sent to Dennis/Coconino or Cheryl/Maricopa. Emails are on the Agenda.

**Global Family Group:** What to do when the bank opens, how to spend American Federation Dollars (AFDs). As we find out how they are going to work that, we will let everybody know.

**Congressional Candidates:** We will be looking for candidates for our Continental Congress. Cheryl/Maricopa suggests Dennis/Coconino explain the position and the requirements in a little more detail. The Assembly will need to elect two Congressional Candidates for Arizona to the Union of States. They will be serving in the lawfull, land and soil jurisdiction Congress. From Congress we get to elect a President of the United States. Eric Belcher is the Head of State and Anna Von Reitz is the Fiduciary.

Diane/Maricopa asks what the qualifications are for those positions. Dennis says you have to be born in the United States. You have to be at least 30 years old.

All the requirements for these offices are in the Constitution. They of coarse have to be

status corrected and have been in the Assembly for some time. Cheryl/Maricopa says that the Continental Congress will be meeting in Philadelphia, which was the original capitol of the foundational government. If she's not mistaken the meeting they are having this July will be to start the restoration of the buildings and other facilities that we will be occupying as the rightful government of the United States of America. They will probably kick off the Continental Congress at that time for the 250 year Aniversary.

**Protocols for voting process:** All votes on Assembly business must be sent by email to either your County Chair or to Dennis/Coconino to be counted. When the vote is counted on the State call, the County Chairs report all votes. The County Chairs will keep a detailed file of all the email noting the name of the voter and their vote. Each County is responsible for emailing all their votes to Dennis/Coconino. There must be a paper trail of all votes. So no votes will be counted that are not emailed to your County Chair or to Dennis/Coconino.
