


Juneteenth Parade and Festival Sat, June 22 @ 9-7 Malcolm X Park, 5100 Pine St	Mark the anniversary of the ratification of the 13th Amendment. The event features a parade starting at 52nd and Jefferson streets as well as a music festival at the park.	
Hispanic Fiesta Sat & Sun, July 6-7 Penns Landing, 101 S Columbus Blvd	The festival celebrates the vibrant cultures of several Latin American countries through music, food, dance, crafts and more.	
Islamic Heritage Festival Sat, July 20 @ 2-8 Penn's Landing	Celebrate with a global market bazaar, giveaways, a fashion show and more.	
ACANA African Festival Sat, Aug 4 @ 2-8 Penns Landing	This concert experience that brings artists, groups and dance troupes from around the African continent to perform traditional dance performances, modern Afropop and reggae musical performances.
