Month	Program	Description
November 13	Introduction Self-Esteem	Introductions/guidelines for the club- talk about self-esteem and complete a self-portrait, self-esteem activity
December 11	GIRLS- Leadership	Girls will be guided in a lesson on leadership and then through leadership activities
January 8	GIRLS- Bullying	Girls will be presented a lesson on bullying and then participate in activities to solidify the lesson - ex. Create a comic strip, play Bully Jeopardy
February 12	GIRLS- Financial Education	Girls will learn about the importance of money in terms of spending, saving and budgeting. They will create their own banks.
