

Meghan Walls, PsyD, is the Director of External Affairs for Delaware Valley and a licensed psychologist with the Division of Behavioral Health at Nemours Children's Health. Dr. Walls holds an appointment as Clinical Assistant Professor of Pediatrics with Sidney Kimmel Medical College at Thomas Jefferson University, and practices within the Nemours primary care network.

As Director of External Affairs, Dr. Walls guides and implements policy and advocacy work for Nemours in the Delaware Valley, including Delaware, Pennsylvania, and New Jersey. She also oversees Community Engagement partnership and sponsorship. Dr. Walls is a thought leader in pediatric healthcare, especially related to mental health, often coordinating with federal and state leaders and elected officials. She has been featured in national, local, and popular media, recently recording a series on Resilient Kids with Michael Phelps.

Dr. Walls has received several awards for her clinical and policy work. In 2019, Dr. Walls was selected for the Nemours Physician Excellence in Community Award as well as the award for NAMI Delaware Healthcare Professional of the Year. Dr. Walls also received the Delaware KidsCOUNT 2020 professional leader and volunteer award for advocating for Delaware's children, Delaware Business Times 40 under 40, and was identified by The News Journal in the category of "Most Influential in Politics". Dr. Walls holds Gubernatorial appointments to the Delaware Early Childhood Council and the Governor's Advisory Council on Substance Use and Mental Health. She co-chairs the Data and Policy Committee for the Lt. Governor's Behavioral Health Consortium.
