Bio: Dr. Diana Montoya-Williams is a neonatologist at the Children's Hospital of Philadelphia and the Hospital for the University of Pennsylvania. She is principal investigator at CHOP's PolicyLab and the Penn Leonard Davis Institute, and an Assistant Professor of Pediatrics in the University of Pennsylvania's Perelman School of Medicine. In addition to taking care of infants in the NICU, Dr. Montoya-Williams studies racial and ethnic inequities in maternal and infant health outcomes, including a focus on immigrant health outcomes. She co-leads the Health Equity Research Methods Initiative at CHOP and the Research and Education Core of CHOP's Center for Health Equity. She also works as a legislative advocate in CHOP's Office of Government Affairs and Health Policy.
