

Deepthiman Gowda, MD, MPH is a general internist and an Associate Professor of Medicine at Columbia University's College of Physicians and Surgeons. He is the Director of Clinical Practice for the Program in Narrative Medicine and the Director of the Foundations of Clinical Medicine, which teaches Columbia's students the art of the medical interview, physical exam, and clinical reasoning. He is a Macy Faculty Scholar and the principal investigator of a Macy Foundation sponsored 2-year study of the effect of narrative medicine on primary care staff team function and work engagement. He is a member of the New York City Board of Health.
