About SuzukiMusic

SuzukiMusic is incorporated as a not-for-profit corporation and all proceeds go to funding faculty development, programming, and our sister school — Vision Nouvelle. We are a member of The Suzuki Association of Ontario and The Suzuki Association of the Americas. All SuzukiMusic teachers are professional musicians, and have received specialized training in Suzuki teaching from accredited Suzuki institutes.

About The Suzuki Method

Founding principles of the Suzuki Method:

1. Expectation of Success

All children can learn to play music.

2. Early Beginning

Suzuki children usually begin to play music when they are between 3-5 years old.

3. Listening

Suzuki students listen every day to recordings of the repertoire they are going to study many months before they begin study.

4. Nurturing

Suzuki parents always encourage their children's musical effort.

5. Social Environment

Suzuki students learn to play music in weekly private lessons and regular group classes

6. Parent Teacher

Suzuki parents are 'home teachers.' They help the child during their daily practice.

7. Repetition

Suzuki students repeat new skills many times until they master them.

8. Performance

Suzuki students have performance opportunities in group lessons and recitals. Their first performance may be a simple bow or song.

9. Review

Suzuki students continue to play their early pieces, using them as the foundation for technical studies and to advance through the repertoire.

10. Natural Reading

Suzuki students learn to read music around 6 years old after they have learned to "play by ear".

Viva Suzuki Funding

Objectives

Funding will enable the school to...

- 1) Provide the faculty with the opportunity to continue to upgrade and refresh their skills. Specialized Suzuki training ensures that our teachers are aware of the best practices and can support every child's learning style effectively.
- 2) Enrich the school's programming, enabling us to bring special guest artists to our Saturday classes to interact with our students, or to purchase music for our reading classes and ensembles.
- 3) Supports Suzuki music education for our sister school, Vision Nouvelle, in Haiti. With the funds raised, we are able to help with the purchase of instruments, music and accessories. This initiative aligns with Dr. Suzuki's vision of changing children's lives through music. It also teaches our children to care for others around the world, using music as an instrument of change and understanding.

Suzuki Music Programs

Private Lessons: Students can have private lessons with their teachers, while the parents sit in on the lessons. Parents are the "at home teachers" and to keep up to date with what the children are learning, the parents will learn along with their child. This enforces good practices at-home. The teachers hold lessons in their home studios, and parents have the option to choose the teacher's studio which is closest to their home.

Group Classes: Suzuki parents and students have the option to enrol in group classes, where the ensemble learns songs together and perform the songs at different events across the city.

Teen Mentorship Program: This is a bi-annual certificate class with Elaine Rass. The teenage students learn how to become mentors to kids, teach children how to effectively practice and learn the Suzuki philosophy. Elaine teaches the full-day of class, which is followed by readings and class observations. The program offers a certificate at the end of the course.

Headstart Program: A pre-instrumental program designed to introduce 3- 4 year olds to basic musical concepts and beginning Suzuki rhythms and repertoire. Emphasis is on rhythm, singing, motor development and aural training, aided by the playing percussion instruments. The students are also introduced to the five instruments taught at our school; Cello, Violin, Viola, Flute and Guitar and are given the opportunity to listen, touch and make sounds on the actual instruments.
