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CYO Rose Rally FOR LIFE Basics

What is the “Rose Rally FOR LIFE?”? It is an all-night fund-raiser held to raise funds for organizations that foster respect for life. It's similar to a relay race where participants pass a baton. Teams of participants are expected to have at least one team member walking the at all times during the night carrying the team's baton, while others support the cause through food, drinks and other purchases. This is a great opportunity to participate in a “big church” type of event where the members of youth groups from around the archdiocese can come together, socialize, have fun and build community while serving others.

What Happens at the “Rose Rally FOR LIFE”? The CYO Rally begins at 9:00pm and runs until 6:00 a.m., with set-up preparations beginning at 7:00pm the day of the event. Relay is an all-night social and school fair-style event for CYO members. We outline our walking 'track' which is surrounded by the "campsites" of each CYO, their base of operation where each group will set up a tent or booth for selling food, providing services (a jail, face painting, bean bags, cots) or some kind of game.

The event has an overall theme. CYOs will decorate their campsites and their batons in a way that reflects that theme. The decorated batons are called “spirit sticks” and are usually decorated to reflect the spirit and enthusiasm of the group.

The “Rose Rally FOR LIFE” is a Celebration

Our Rally is a celebration of life in all its phases from conception to natural death as well as a memorial to innocent lives lost. As Church we are called to be proactive in the defense of life. We are all precious in the eyes of the Lord.

Other Activities

There are other activities that attendees can participate in:

- There will be music all night long!
- The “Rally Olympics” are competitive goofy games played throughout the night
- Theme times are announced where walkers can dress in theme to walk the track (examples: 80's clothes, superhero items, patriotic, favorite holiday)
- A "No Talent" Talent Show open to all.
- Midnight Mass, which everyone attends. Adoration and confession will also be available.
- Contests for Best Decorated Campsite; Best Decorated Spirit Stick, and Most Spirited Group. Prizes awarded for each contest at the end of the night.

Who Can Attend “Rose Rally For LIFE?” The rally is open to any youth (8th-12th grade) who are part of a recognized Catholic parish youth ministry program or high school. Participants must be accompanied by adult chaperones (safe environment compliant) who are affiliated with the attending parish/school. **Youth attendees must be covered by CYO/archdiocesan insurance.**

CYO Rose Rally for Life 2022 Reminders:

Behavior: All Catholic school and CYO/ministry group rules of conduct, respect, language, attire, substances, etc. will be fully enforced at this event. **Proper behavior is required and expected.**

Campsites: **Campsites can be set-up as early as 7 p.m. the day of the Rally.** Each CYO will have a campsite on or around the track. This is your team's "base of operation" and you are encouraged to do with it what you will -- Set up a tent, put up a banner, decorate; promote your own CYO events, etc. Please bring at least one table to use at your campsite. Campsites should be ready to go by 8:30 p.m. the night of the event. You will also need to provide your own tent/tarp, chairs, extra lights etc. Please remember to come ready to set up your campsite as soon as you arrive. Personal belongings for your group should also be kept in this area.

Clean-Up – Very Important: Each group is responsible for maintaining their own area, and **ALL** participants will be required to help everyone else clean up **the entire Rally area** at the end of the night, not just their own areas. Please bring some *trash bags* for your site and a broom and dustpan. We will have trash cans around the area for you to use.

Food/Drinks/Water: The event coordinators will **not** be providing any food, drinks, or ice outside of that provided and sold by the groups themselves. Because many groups raise funds by selling food and drinks, **you are encouraged to bring spending money instead of your own food.** Do be sure to bring water bottles; we will have water filling stations to keep you hydrated throughout the night.

Mass: We will celebrate Mass at midnight in church. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will also be available for a portion of the evening.

Insurance: Remember, new insurance must be paid up on July 1st, 2022, one month before the event. **Make sure that your participants are insured through the archdiocese and paid up!**

Roses: We will be offering roses as a monetary donation item, similar to the luminary bags that we used for our former relays. Paper roses will be displayed at the Rally.

Money: Please bring a moneybox with plenty of small bills and coins for change, and **have your teens bring only small bills to spend – no \$20 bills!** Typically each person will spend about \$20-\$30 through the night.

Permission/Medical Forms: please have each youth group member fill out a copy of the "Parental Permission / Medical Consent Form" included in this packet. We will leave it up to you to hold on to these forms during the event, but they will be required for any and all members coming to this event.

Rain Plan: In the event of inclement weather we will gather under the overhangs around the church or in the gym.

Registration: **There are no WALK-IN registrations! Please DO NOT ASK.** All Rally participants must pre-register by Site Night on July 27, 2022 from 5:30-7:30 p.m. You may wish to purchase extra wristbands on Site Night if you think you may need them.

Security: We will have JPSO Officers throughout the night. Let members know that backpacks, bags, will be subject to search at their discretion.

Theme Hours: We will have some “Theme Times” at various times during the night when participants will be asked to wear or carry items that fit the theme. Encourage your teens to bring whatever items they will need to participate at these times. Theme details will be determined at the planning session and announced before the event.

Wristbands: We will issue wristbands to ALL participants. These must be worn throughout the night and must be given to all registered participants prior to entrance to St. Angela Merici. Wristbands will be handed out at Site Night.

CYO Rose Rally For Life Contest List:

Spirit Award: The group that displays the most enthusiasm will be deemed “Most Spirited” and will have their name added to the Spirit Banner to be displayed each year at the Rose Rally FOR LIFE! Groups try to top each other in loudness, creativity, or other displays of spirit. Groups are judged as a whole, regardless of size.

Best Decorated Campsite: Campsites are judged on theme, decorations, inclusion of costumes or t-shirts, creativity and overall presentation. Judging will be after the opening ceremonies. A trophy will be awarded to the winning team.

Best Decorated Batons/Spirit Sticks: A baton or spirit stick representing your team is carried on the track at all times. Batons can be as elaborate as you want and are judged on creativity and theme. A trophy will be awarded to the winning team.

Rally Olympics: We will have several goofy games throughout the night. The group winning the most games, or performing the best overall, will win the Rally Olympics! A traveling trophy is awarded for this contest. The winner keeps the trophy until next year.

“No-Talent” Talent Show: The worse you are, the better you’ll do! No talent is needed, just a commitment to let yourself be laughed at! Contestants get 3 minutes to prove that they have (no) talent! Winners are decided by applause from the crowd after all contestants have performed. The more elaborate, the better. Contestants should bring their own music and any props needed.




