

How to Use the CMA Discussion Forums

How do I access the discussion forum?

All discussion forums are listed on the [Discussion Forum page](#) of the CMA website. Simply click on the forum you'd like to access. To get access to a specific discussion forum, please send an email to communication@cmadocs.org.

How do I know which discussion forums I'm part of?

While you're logged into the CMA website, go to [My CMA](#) > My Account > My Groups

You will see a list of discussion forums you currently have access to.

Who can post new content and where?

Official Business – Forum administrators only. All other forum members can respond.

Open Discussions – All forum members and administrators can post content here.

How to post a new topic

Go to your discussion forum landing page and click on “Open Discussions”. You may post a new topic or respond to an existing topic.
