Our examination of *Who Can We Be Together*, a Biblical exploration of Luke 13 written by Candace Simpson, will bring participants deeper in to Jesus' teachings to explore what it means to be in community. As the author notes, "For followers of Christ 2,000 years later, it's important for us to sit with the range of emotions we have in response to these words. It's not easy to build and sustain communities, especially when there are forces that drain us, exhaust us, and even push us to act uncharacteristically. And yet, we are called to act on the most ethical principles of our faith so we can witness the kin-dom of God on earth." The goal of this study is to inspire a global community of justice-oriented believers to challenge damaging theologies and create healthy rituals for abundant living.
