

### Solar Photovoltaic and Energy Storage Pre-Qualified Design-Build Contractors

The City of Los Angeles is undertaking the installation of solar photovoltaic (PV) and

energy storage systems at municipal facilities. This program will promote renewable power generation, offset municipal electricity consumption, reduce greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions, ensure operational resilience, improve utility grid reliability, and lead by example on solar and energy storage goals.

Contractors may be asked to design, design and build, just build, and potentially help facilitate the financing of new solar PV systems, solar PV and energy storage systems, or just energy storage systems. The scope of work will be defined in future bid documents issued to the prequalified list of professional design-build contractors that will be identified through this RFQ process.


