Coronavirus Update: Telebriefing for Food and Agriculture Industry Workers **Public Health Officials Provide Update on Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19)**

Los Angeles County continues making progress in reducing the average number of new COVID cases and hospitalizations. Last week, the 7-day average of new cases was 2,292, which is down 35% compared to the previous week. The 3-day average number of people hospitalized hit its peak on January 8th, with 8,000 hospitalizations. That number has since decreased by more than 65%. While we share cautious optimism with others, we must remain vigilant and continue to take the necessary precautions to keep the trend headed in this direction. Public Health will conduct a telebriefing to update you on the latest COVID-19 response, go through updates of the Health Officer Order, answer your questions, and listen to your feedback.
