**Housing for the Harvest** is the current program that will offer temporary hotel housing to farm and food processing workers who need to isolate due to COVID-19.

**COVID-19 Testing**: There are **Six testing sites**: Dodger Stadium, Hansen Dam, Crenshaw Christian Center, Jackie Robinson Stadium (VA Lot 15), Lincoln Park Recreation Center and Warner Center. **Two Walk-in testing sites**: Carbon Health/Echo Park and Kedren Community Health Center. **One Homeless Outreach Mobile Unit**. **Grand Total** as of September 16, 2020: 2,079,592.\*

**All drive-through sites have changed their operational hours 8:00am – 2:00pm Monday through Saturday.** These changes will remain in effect through September 30, 2020

**The LA Regional COVID-19 Recovery Fund** is now open to micro-entrepreneurs, small businesses, and non-profits located in Los Angeles County that meet certain criteria. Upon completion, businesses receive a COVID-19 Safety Compliance Certificate that can be posted on storefronts.
