FREE FLU SHOTS WILL SOON BE OFFERED AT SELECT LA COUNTY LIBRARIES, COVID-19 TESTING IS AVAILABLE, AND THE 'CSCCP'

Coming Soon: Free Flu Shots at Select LA County Libraries



Beginning this October, LA County's Department of Public Health (DPH) and LA County Library will be offering free flu vaccines to those 6 months of age & older at select Library locations across the County. Flu shot clinic dates & locations for October & November 2020 are being finalized and will be announced [here](#), once available. Health insurance will not be a requirement.

If you're thinking of getting a flu vaccine, LA County recommends calling your regular health care provider to see what other shots you may need. If you don't have a regular provider, dial 2-1-1 (the LA County Information Line) or visit publichealth.lacounty.gov for a list of no cost or low-cost vaccine providers. Stay tuned for updates!

COVID-19 Testing is Available



If you think you may be experiencing COVID-19 symptoms or have been exposed to someone who tested positive for COVID-19, call your primary care provider to schedule a COVID-19 test. COVID-19 symptoms include:

fever, cough, difficulty breathing, chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, and/or new loss of taste or smell.

Wherever possible, you should receive testing in consultation with your healthcare provider to ensure continuity of care & optimal follow-up. If you do not have insurance & need help connecting to a healthcare provider, dial 2-1-1.

COVID-19 Safety Compliance Certification Program



LA County is helping train businesses on the implementation of COVID-19 safety protocols through a no-cost online training course called the **COVID-19 Safety Compliance Certification Program** (CSCCP). Once completed, business owners receive a certificate, and window seal to display on their storefront, which can reassure employees and customers alike that the business is following COVID-19 infection control and physical distancing requirements.
