

Perennials from the Saint Paul's Churchyard Gardens



Amsonia "Blue Star"

Starry, light blue flowers bloom atop dark stems. Native perennial thrives with little care. Incredibly durable and tolerant of heat, cold and drought. Plant in sunny location.



Salvia "Black & Blue"

Gorgeous cobalt blue with black blooms emerge from black whorls along the tall flower spikes, rising from the lush, green, aromatic foliage. Excellent for adding dark, dramatic contrast to any garden. Sensational season-long, heat-loving color for sunny beds and borders. An herbaceous perennial that returns every year. Plant in sunny location.



Shasta Daisy "Alaska"

A perennial flower with pure glistening white flowers. These white daisies measure roughly 4"-5" across with a beautiful, buttery yellow center. Each plant sends up dozens of tall, sturdy stems from a clean, dark green bush. Plant in sunny location.
