

CSI Pacific COVID Testing

The CSI Pacific Medical Clinic **will provide** asymptomatic COVID-19 testing to athletes, coaches and other staff that are eligible under the following circumstances:

1. Asymptomatic test required in anticipation to entering a training camp bubble; or
2. Asymptomatic test required prior to domestic or international travel; or
3. Asymptomatic test required upon return from domestic travel

CSI Pacific **will not provide** COVID-19 testing to anyone under the following circumstances:

1. Individual exhibits COVID-19 symptoms
2. Individual has been in close contact to someone who tested positive for COVID-19
3. Any individual who will be returning from international travel

There are 3 avenues for testing available at this time.

A. Public Testing

In BC, COVID testing is available only for those that have symptoms. A list of testing locations by health region can be found at: <https://experience.arcgis.com/experience/3862560c5a41418e9d78f4f81688e9d0>

B. Private pay clinics

There are some private pay clinics in the Vancouver region that offer testing for a fee to people who require asymptomatic testing for reasons that fall outside of B.C. public health recommendations, as outlined in the testing guidelines, such as for travel or employment.

C. CSI Pacific - LifeLabs

CSI Pacific is looking to confirm asymptomatic testing through LifeLabs for affiliated sports and athletes for the purposes of travel or for use in a training bubble.

- All bookings (individual or group) made through Nitin Tailor (medical@csipacific.ca)
- Please provide all booking requests 10 days in advance of when your results are needed as it can take up to 72 hrs post-test for results.
- The cost of each test will be \$165 + staff costs (for Physician or RN) and paid for by sport (international travel, sport training camp bubble) or individual (Christmas related travel).

A further update will be provided with this option is confirmed.

Point of Care Devices

- At this time the Songbird Point of Care device is not accredited in BC, as the College of Physician and Surgeons of BC requires a medical laboratory accreditation for all COVID testing. As a result, this device not available for use at this time in BC outside of an accredited lab.
