

Covid 19 Testing in Atlantic Provinces

No COVID-19 testing is performed at CSI Atlantic.

New Brunswick

- symptomatic testing PCR test, do online self-assessment and can request a test online or call 811
- public health does contact tracing and will contact you if close contact of confirmed positive
- workers or travelers can fill out an online form to request an asymptomatic test
- private testing available through ICHOR Blood Services in Fredericton PCR and antibody testing, receive test results in 24 hours
- 14 day self-isolation for anyone coming in

PEI

- symptomatic testing, schedule a PCR test online or go to drop in site or call 811
- can call for asymptomatic test for work or travel 1 855 354 4358
- will receive neg results in 72 hours
- Chief Public Health Officer will contact you if positive
- different number to call if testing needed for international travel
- no private testing
- self isolation for everyone coming into the province for 14 days
- anyone leaving for work must “work isolate” when gets back
- hockey teams QJMHL and Junior A testing when arrive on the island to play

Newfoundland

- for symptomatic PCR testing use 811 website for self-assessment to determine if you need a test
- private PCR testing available from Avalon Lab cost
- can ask for an exemption for modified self-isolation if from Atlantic Canada
- self-isolation for everyone coming into the province for 14 days

Nova Scotia

- PCR testing available for symptomatic and asymptomatic
- schedule online or call 811 - can schedule up to 3 days ahead of time
- several rapid testing sites and mobile units moving around the province using Abbott antigen tests
- private PCR testing available for \$250 per test
- 14 day self-isolation for anyone coming in other than from PEI and NL
- rotational workers have their own testing schedule
