NEXT STEPS

BECOME A CHRISTIAN

God sent Jesus, His perfect Son, to rescue and redeem us. We are sinful, broken people in desperate need of a Savior. Jesus lived a perfect life, died on the cross for our sins, and rose from the grave three days later. He conquered sin and death in our place. We become a new Christian when we repent of our sin and place our trust in Jesus alone to save us.



BAPTISM

Baptism is the way we go public with our faith in Jesus. It is a beautiful picture of the gospel as believers are immersed in water in the same way Jesus died, was buried, and raised to life. Baptism is the next step for those who have trusted in Jesus and committed to following Him. Pastors are available down front after each service, and staff are available at the Connect Center to discuss baptism.



MEMBERSHIP

JOIN SUNDAY SCHOOL

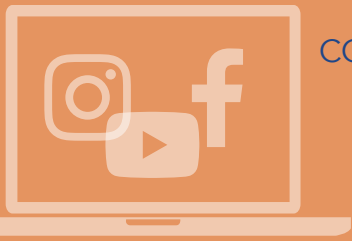
SUNDAY SCHOOL
