

CATHOLIC SCHOOL TUITION ASSISTANCE



Parishioners are invited to apply for Catholic School tuition assistance (grades K-12) for the upcoming 2024-2025 academic year. Tuition grants are distributed from the Frederick County Parish Tuition Assistance Fund, established by eight parishes in southern Frederick County. The monthly offering for Catholic School Education goes directly into this fund to assist qualifying families; tuition assistance payments are made directly to the schools.

To be considered for a grant:

- ◆ Families must be registered parishioners and contribute financially on a regular basis either through envelopes or electronic funds transfer (EFT), or support the parish through consistent stewardship of time and talent.
- ◆ Child(ren) must be Catholic and enrolled in an Archdiocesan-approved Catholic School (elementary or high school).

Process:

- ◆ The distribution committee uses the FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment to conduct financial need evaluations, a fair and confidential process. Awards are made on financial need.
- ◆ Processing fee of \$35 is assessed.
- ◆ To apply, scan the QR code or go to online.factsmgt.com to set up account; or login if you already have an account.
- ◆ Designate both a school and your parish of registration.

- ◆ To be eligible for assistance, application must be in a **"VERIFIED" status prior to March 31.**

- ◆ Assistance awards are expected to be finalized by the middle of May.
