The Standard Response Protocol (SRP) and Standard Reunification Method (SRM) One-Day Reunification Exercise (Rex)

This one-day workshop takes a deep dive into what both programs are and how to begin using them, including a brief segment on incident command and how it relates to crisis management for educators, and functional reunification exercises.

Illinois Fire Service Institute trainers are trained by the I Love You Guys Foundation to deliver this specialized program.

All stakeholders in reunification are encouraged to take part in this exercise to prepare organizations to conduct an actual reunification including district and school staff, public safety, emergency managers, mental health professionals, and community leaders.
