- Campus Update
 - CDC Health and Safety protocols are still in place on campus.
 - Covid Cleaning for Sanctuary was on Thursday October 29, 2020.
 - Worked with DEK Roofing to finally fix Sanctuary roof on Friday November 6, 2020. Fixed right before Tropical Storm Eta, happy to report no leaks after torrential downpour, Yeah!! Reporting no other leaks in Fellowship Hall either.
- Perimeter Fence Project/Campus Safety
 - Process to remove Pokémon Go game from our property.
 - Campus Safety is a daily priority with multiple instances ranging from homeless persons sleeping on campus during preschool drop-off, duck feeding, fishing, Pokémon stop and gym, neighborhood walk through, to anyone simply camping out on property for no reason.
 - Obtained 3 proposals from fencing companies for review Funding stream is congregational donations, brick fundraiser, and individual donors. Checking for grants and other funding.

Curriculum Corner Toddlers- 2's and 3's

One-year old participate in finger art, Bible time, singing and sharing skills. Goals for two-year old include following directions, listening and sharing with help from puppet "Amber Lamb." They will review colors, letters and shapes. Three-year old learn number concepts, count from 1-15 review letters A-F. Bible verse is Genesis 26:24.


VPK-4 year Olds


