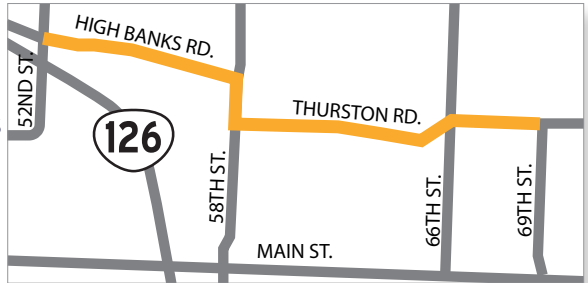


HIGH BANKS AND THURSTON ROAD OVERLAY PROJECT

As part of 2018 voter-approved GO Bond Measure 20-296 for Springfield street fixes, repairs to **High Banks and Thurston Roads** will begin in early June 2021.

Where will work take place?

- High Banks Road from 52nd Street to 58th Street.
- 58th Street from High Banks Road to Thurston Road.
- Thurston Road from 58th Street to 69th Street.



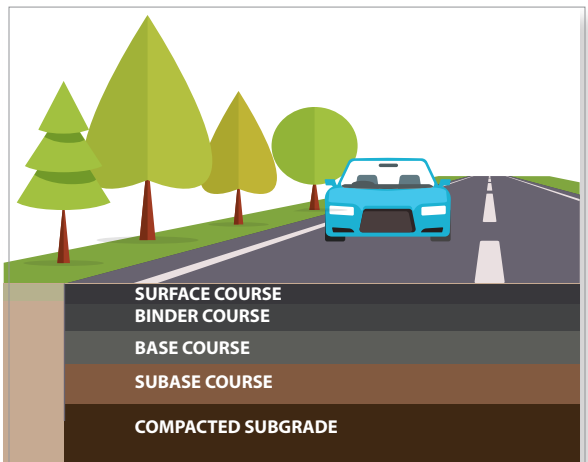
What's planned?

Necessary street repairs consist of milling and paving with some full depth repairs for areas with extensive damage. Both projects will have new street striping. To meet current standards, most of the existing Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) sidewalk ramps require updates.

When will work happen?

JUNE - SEPTEMBER 2021

Daytime work will include ADA ramp construction followed by roadway reconstruction and paving.



All schedules are subject to change due to weather conditions.
