

Article Submission Guidelines

This is a guide to make sure that all necessary information is included with *BSCESNews* article submissions. Please fill out the Author(s) Information and Article Information tables below. The article itself may be written in this Microsoft Word file or attached as a separate word document, and all photographs and graphics should be attached as separate image files.

Article Submission Requirements

Submit your article, this form, and photos to: newsletter.board@bsces.org.

BSCESNews articles should:

- Be submitted in Microsoft Word format.
- Have a word count of 400 to 1,500 words (1-2 pages, html format allows flexibility in length).
- Have a local or regional focus.
- Preferably reflect the theme or featured group for the month. However, we frequently include articles with other relevant or timely articles of interest of civil engineers.
- Include 1-3 photos/graphics as separate high-resolution jpeg or png files named as Photo/Figure 1, 2, 3. Include captions in the Article Information Table below. Formatting constraints may prevent us from placing a photograph or image at a specific point in the text, so the text should reference photos/figures appropriately. Images may be cropped/resized as necessary.

Article Submission Deadlines

Article submission deadlines are typically the end of the previous month for the next month's issue. For the 2020-2021 *BSCESNews* publishing cycle, article deadlines are:

September (Climate Change Mitigation) – Due September 3, 2021
October (Transportation) – Due October 1, 2021
November (Structural Design) – Due October 29, 2021
December (Geotechnical Practices) – Due December 3, 2021
January (Innovative Technologies) – Due December 31, 2021
February (Water & Environmental Solutions) – Due January 28, 2022
March (Construction) – Due February 25, 2022
April (Outreach & Volunteerism) – Due April 1, 2022
May (Utility Engineering) – Due April 29, 2022
June (Emergency Preparedness) – Due June 3, 2022
