Service Retreat:

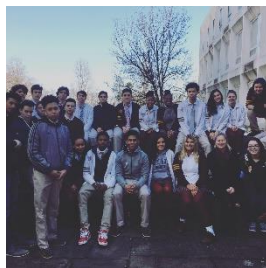
Thursday, February 18th
