Partnership with the City of Orinda - Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion

Board Vice President Liz Daoust, Board Member Hillary Weiner, Director of Curriculum David Schrag, and I have met twice with Orinda's Mayor Darlene Gee, City Manager Steve Salomon, and Chief of Police David Cook to review current diversity, equity, and inclusion efforts and determine ways we can partner together to help ensure that "Everyone Belongs Here" is realized within our schools and the broader community. I was invited to speak at the September 15th City Council Meeting to share highlights of the school district's work in this important area as well as potential opportunities for collaboration between the two agencies, including:

- Community Town Hall on Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion
- Anti-Bias Training for All Elected Officials (City Council and School Board) along with top administrative staff
- Shared Proclamation in Support of Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion
- Potential Speaker Series

At our meeting on 9/14, the City and Orinda USD committed to holding monthly diversity, equity, and inclusion committee meetings to ensure the continued momentum of this critical work.

Progress on Measures E and I Facilities Projects

This week Dara Youngdale, Principal with HKIT architectural firm, shared the vision for Sleepy Hollow's new multipurpose room (MPR) with school stakeholders including teachers, parents, and neighbors and answered their questions.
